Keehner moved, Peterson seconded to approve the minutes of the March 17, 2020 meeting. Ayes: Keehner and Peterson. Motion carried.

Keehner moved, Peterson seconded to approve the claims as presented totaling \$52,453.65. Ayes: Keehner and Peterson. Motion carried.

Vising Nursing and Public Health requested an increase in their budget to help with increased hours and supplies needed to help fight against the pandemic. Given the fluidity of the event, the Board will monitor the situation and will discuss a budget amendment at a later date.

The Board received an update regarding public health concerns relating to COVID-19. Keehner moved, Peterson seconded to direct county department heads and elected officials to determine which of their employees will be considered situationally essential for current duties and which employees are not, and that non-essential employees will receive paid administrative leave until the end of March for the time that they are not considered essential. Keehner moved, Peterson seconded to have employees subjected to isolation and quarantine guidelines of IPDH if found to have symptoms or returning from out of state or vacation as determined by Clayton County VNA/Public Health. Ayes: Keehner and Peterson. Motion carried.
