

The CCHPC meet on June 14, 2019 at Froelich Museum. Ellen Collins called the meeting to order at 9am with the following commission members present, Gary Goyette, Lee Lenth, John Nikolai, Milton Johnson and Roger Thomas.

Motion by Johnson to approve the June 14, 2019 as printed. Motion carried unanimously.

Nikolai updated the progress of attaining a video system for the clock tower restoration. Moellering Electric will be installing the wiring in the courthouse for the video system.

Mederville Bridge

Members met with Lucille Hubbard who lives next to the bridge. They were able to attain historic pictures of the bridge, mill and railroad from her. Ideas for the bridge were to clean the deck, allowing for events to be held on the bridge, determine who maintains the trails and are adjacent to the bridge and property liability.

Clock Tower re-dedication

Members were asked to collect any photos of the restoration and select those that are quality and worthy of sharing. Photos should show the tower in deterioration, progress then completed. Goyette will lead the photo committee with help from Nikolai. Other items to be included for display will be the roundels, old clock hands and historic names found on the tower walls.

Collins reported that Nicolai has reimbursed for Preservation Summit. The commission paid \$125 to the Motor Mill Foundation for the Iowa State Fair one day booth rental.

Thomas reported on the bridges that are being considered for preservation. Thomas will be working with a professional photographer to take pictures of select bridges.

Motion by Goyette to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
