Employee Benefits

Dispatcher/Jailer

Wage:

The dispatch/jailer starting Wage is \$16.61 set out in the Chauffers, Teamster, and Helpers Local 238 contract. This includes incremental increases over a two year period. Shift differential of .30 cents per hour also applies for hours worked during 8pm-6am. The employee will also be given longevity pay after 10 years of continuous service.

Health Insurance:

Clayton County Pays full single health insurance, and family health insurance is available at an additional cost to the employee.

Sick Time:

Employees earn 16 hours of sick leave per calendar month of continuous employment. After 90 days of sick time is accrued, the next 24 days may be converted into vacation.

Life Insurance:

Clayton County will purchase a \$20,000 term life insurance Policy for each full time employee.

Vacation:

After 1 year of employment, the employee will receive 40 hours vacation. After 2 years of employment the employee will receive 80 hours of vacation per year. After 6 years of employment the employee will receive 100 hours of vacation per year. After 10 years of employment the employee will receive 120 hours of vacation per year. After 17 years of employment the employee will receive 160 hours of vacation per year.

Holidays:

Clayton County Recognizes 11 paid holidays with 1 floating holiday

Clothing and Equipment:

The Sheriff's Office will provide the employee with necessary clothing and equipment

Hours of Work:

The Clayton County Sheriff's Office works 10 hour shifts, 4 days per week. The schedule is on a rotation where you work every other weekend. Current shifts begin at 4, 6, and 8 AM, and 4,6,8 PM. Shifts are bid by seniority and/or appointed by the Sheriff.

Union:

After a probationary period, the employee may join the Chauffers, Teamster, and Helpers Local 238 at an additional cost the employee.
