Sheriff Mike Tschirgi presented the Board with a contract with Iowa Technologies to provide IT services for the Law Enforcement center for FY22. The contract would be for 24/7 coverage with reduced hourly rates and mileage. The Board discussed proposed upgrades to the courtroom with Clerk of Court Johnna Sutton and Lori Pope. Changes are desired to make the jury box ADA accessible and improve security for the judge and witnesses. The FY22 budget will be reviewed to see what, if any, improvements can be made in the coming year and input will be sought to plan for future upgrades.
